About Angel

ANGEL is a web-based course management and collaboration tool that helps instructors and students communicate and collaborate quickly, easily, and effectively.

With ANGEL, you can download assignments, take quizzes and tests, send and receive course mail, post to threaded discussions and chat rooms, submit assignments using drop-boxes, and more. You can also check your progress and grades at any time during the course, and can create groups and teams for project or committee work.

Logging into ANGEL

To log into ANGEL you will need access to the Internet and a Web browser.

To log into ANGEL:

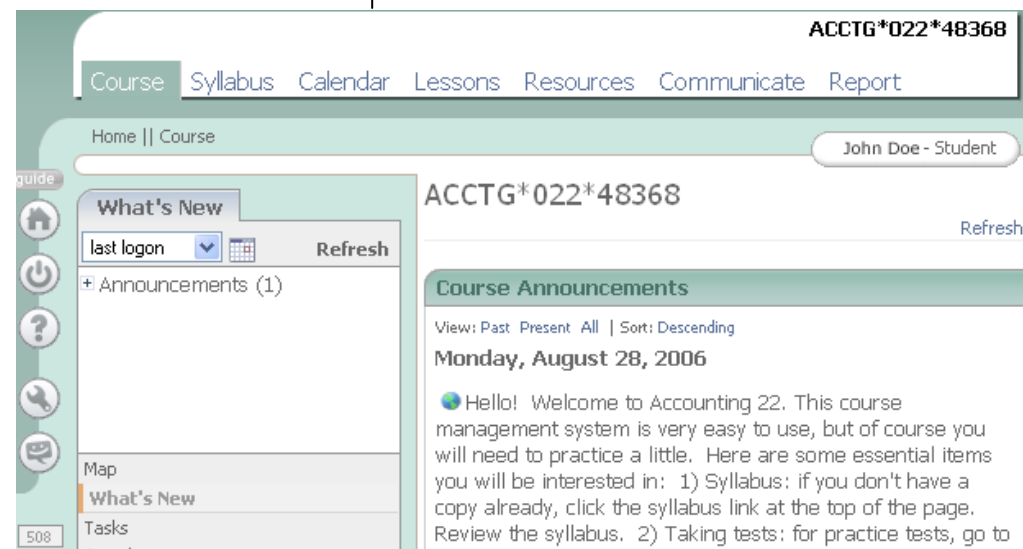
Personal Home Page

The home page includes access to announcements, new assignments and course materials via the What's New Tab, and a course map.



The course home page includes six additional tabs:

1. **Syllabus**— contains links to the course syllabus
2. **Calendar**— includes a personal and course calendar
3. **Lessons**— includes access to all course materials, such as lecture notes, handouts, quizzes, and discussion forums
4. **Resources**— includes course and institutional resources
5. **Communicate**— includes course mail, chat and discussion forums
6. **Report**— Includes features to allow you to view grades and milestones assigned by your teacher
